A. Please note, the bid deadline for the Bus Stop Pole Lights HAS BEEN CHANGED to

## 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 12, 2020.

Please change your records accordingly.

- B. Revisions to the Technical Specifications
- 1. The DTA will accept a push button to activate the pole light as an approved equal to the motion detection system.
  - a. The push button shall be of an industrial standard to withstand the local weather conditions in the DTA service area. Upon activation, the light will remain on for a minimum of five minutes, up to fifteen minutes, at 100% brightness.
- 2. Please DELETE the requirement for a 10000 lumen output fixture:
  - % Color shall be 10000 lumens and color temperature of 6000K 7200K.+

%LED Lumens:

100W (10000 Lumens)+

- 3. Please INSERT the following:
  - %. Light shall be high intensity LED downlighting to sufficiently light the stop area, a minimum of 3 watts, with a minimum of a 20W solar array.+
- 4. A Lead Acid (AGM) battery is approved as an equal.
- 5. Please DELETE the following:
  - %1. Lights must have the capability of being turned on or off using a simple remote to test the lights during the daytime for maintenance verification. A minimum of three remotes is required.+
- 6. Please INSERT the following:
- %1. The light system must have the capability to test the lights during the day for maintenance purposes, either through a remote that turns lights on and off, or a magnet to determine the system is operational, or some other mechanism to verify the health of the system. Bidder must provide details on maintenance requirements along with Bid, along with a list of any spare parts recommended and the price for the spares.

If the Bid includes the remote option, three remotes must be included in the Bid price.+
