Addendum #1

- 1. Answers to questions to date:
 - a. Although the DTA will permit energy drinks in the machines, they will not waive the requirement for resealable plastic bottles. No cans are permitted.
 - b. The DTA has received \$7,588 in vending revenue in the since October 2020.
 - c. No additional machines will be permitted at the Duluth Transportation Center due to space restrictions.
 - d. Vendors may propose a different type of machine, one that offers different products, but the DTA reserves the right to reject machines that will encroach on the customer walkway or presents products that are not acceptable to the DTA.
 - e. The cost proposal may be structured based on the type of machine offered, and an alternate proposal is permitted for the same types of vending machines that are present in the building already.
 - f. Coffee machines at the Operations Center are not necessary since the drivers have a coffeemaker available to them at no charge.
