Please note, the Bid due date HAS BEEN CHANGED to 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 13, 2022.

Clarifications to date:

- 1. Delivery of the signs has been extended to October 31, 2022. Completed signs may be shipped in increments as they are completed.
- 2. Clarification: The DTA will be reviewing the estimated cost of shipping in conjunction with the cost of the signs using an estimated cost of a sample shipment of 500 signs from the vendor point of origination to the DTA Operations Center to determine total cost of the award.
- 4. Bidders that plan to bid signs that deviate from the specifications may submit the deviation in a separate letter with the bid. The DTA reserves the right to accept or reject all deviations at its sole discretion.
- 5. DTA is revising the warranty requirement to a minimum of 5 years due to the type of paint that is specified for the signs. Longer warranty periods are acceptable.
- 6. Non hexavalent chromium conversion coating on aluminum in accordance with ASTM B921 standards is accepted as an approved equal for the galvanized aluminum with white anti-corrosion coating as noted in Addendum 2.
- 7. The DTA requires 0.100-gauge signs so they are interchangeable throughout the transit system and are compatible with existing mounting brackets.
- 8. No further questions will be accepted.
