

REQUEST FOR BIDS Transit Fare Media

1. Please note: The due date for the Transit Fare Cards Request for Bids HAS BEEN CHANGED to **1:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 8, 2022**. Please change all references to the due date accordingly.

2. Clarifications to date:

- a. The DTA does not have any samples of the fare media. We are just implementing the fare media for the first time.
- b. We do not have any special packing instructions for delivery of the fare media, other than they must arrive in working condition.
- c. The media is a standard size, approximately 2.125-inches by 3.375 inches, and includes a 4-card imprint on the front side of the card, and a 1-color imprint of the Token ID on the back of the card. There is nothing else printed on the back of the card.
- d. The DTA will provide the selected Vendor a Vector file with the front side design that is scaled to fit on the card. It is a 4-color design not including the white background. (For Vendors who paint the white, it should be priced as a 5-color design.)
- e. The fare cards must have a minimum of 4kB of memory.
- 3. The fare media programming includes security measures to ensure they are PCI compliant. Further clarifications regarding the programming requirements will be issued no later than Thursday, December 1, 2022.
